The British People's Party was a British far right political party founded in 1939 and led by ex-British Union of Fascists (BUF) member and Labour Party Member of Parliament John Beckett. The new party supported an immediate end to the Second World War, and was vehemently opposed to usury, calling to mind some of the economic policies of Hilaire Belloc. After the outbreak of the Second World War the BPP was involved in British Union of Fascists-led initiatives to forge closer links between the disparate groups on the far right. The BPP officially disbanded in 1954. The party has been relaunched several times since then.

This meeting was to discuss an official link between our two movements with a view to a possible merger. Talks went really well, a spokesman for BPP will be attending the NBU Rally in September where he will be making an important announcement.
