## The True Nature of Fascism

There is a misconception, a lie, propagated by democrats, capitalists, socialists, and their lapdog media, that Fascism is both destructive and evil. One should always remember that the coward will always point to others to disguise his own faults.

Fascism is, by its nature a dynamic force; a movement for change; a movement that should never cling to the past.

## **FIRE**

Fascism is often described as 'The Third Way'; a path between the Left and the Right. A synthesis of capitalism and socialism.

The thesis of Fascism is that there is a better way. Both the Left and Right have something to offer and Fascism seeks to take best from each.

Fire is a metaphor for change; radical change, change that will transform a nation.
